Dear colleagues, some good news:

## The WIENER AUSGABE of Wittgenstein's writings has found a new publisher: Vittorio Klostermann in Frankfurt am Main

Springer International decided that they would not continue the edition of the WIENER AUSGABE which was originally published by Springer Wien New York, the edition is now being continued by Vittorio Klostermann in Frankfurt am Main.

This month the first new volume of the WIENER AUSGABE has been published, WA 8,2 the second part of the Synopsis TS 211 from Wittgenstein's manuscript volumes V to X. Five more volumes will be published in 2019: WA 10,1, 2 und 3, a collection of cuttings TS 212, from which Wittgenstein dictated the *Big Typescript*, and WA 7 with the reconstructed fragment of Wittgenstein's synopsis TS 208 together with synopsis TS 210 from manuscript volumes I to IV as well as a student edition of the *Big Typescript*.

In 2020 six more volumes will be published: WA 12,1, 2 und 3 Wittgenstein's first revision of the *Big Typescript*, a two volume, bi-lingual apparatus *Biography 1929–32* and a commentary volume to the genesis of *Philosophical Remarks*.
